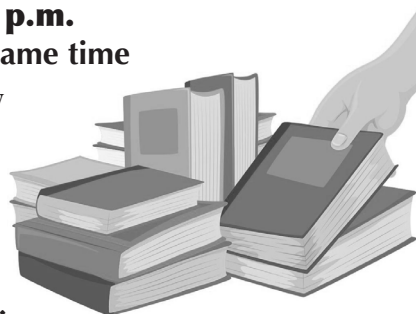

## Library Receives Competitive Grant from the American Library Association
