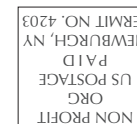
## Children's S.T.E.A.M. Kits Coming Soon!

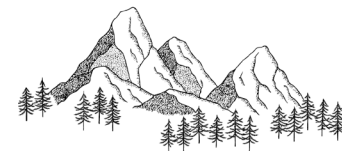

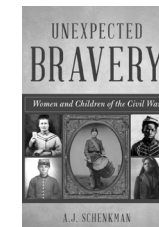

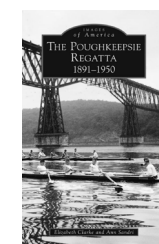
