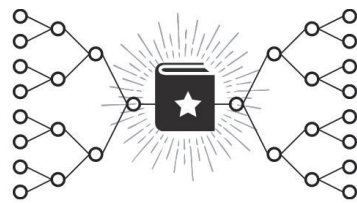

The new year brings good news, as the staff and Board of Trustees are happy to announce that the Library is a recipient of a New York State Aid for Library Construction grant in the amount of \$496,954, for an expansion and renovation of its community room and north side entrance. This amount was the largest awarded in the Hudson Valley for the 2021-2022 grant cycle.

The Library also received a donation in the amount of \$138,903 from the James and Elizabeth Manion Charitable Trust. The new **James & Elizabeth Manion Community Room** project will increase the size of the current community room, and will feature upgraded technology, storage and furniture solutions, natural light, energy saving systems, improved ADA accessibility, and the option to accommodate multiple groups and programs at once. The project is fully funded through the grant, donations such as the Charitable Trust, and the Library's building fund.

The late Elizabeth 'Libby' Manion, was a former director of the Library, and a stalwart supporter of libraries, as well as the Marlborough community. Her dedication to providing a *purpose-driven library* is a model to be followed well into the future. Thank you, Libby!

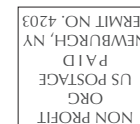
